Key Votes

SB 1123 (state contract lobbyists; prohibition) --AZFEC SUPPORTS

Codifies Governor Ducey's Executive Order that prohibits state agencies using tax dollars to hire contract lobbyists.

SB 1072 (administrative review; scope of review)--AZFEC SUPPORTS

Currently under judicial "Chevron" deference, when a business challenges an agency action in court, the judge is required to defer to the agency on questions of law and fact. This is bad case law that has empowered agencies to expand their scope and power. This bill would have overturned this in AZ.

HB 2447 (civil asset forfeiture; report information; remedies;)--AZFEC SUPPORTS

Reverses the one-way attorney fees, increases the burden of proof, increases reporting, prohibits local agencies from turning forfeitures to Federal agencies to circumvent state law, and improves accountability for the expenditure of forfeiture funds.

SB 1431 (empowerment scholarships; expansion; phase-in)--AZFEC SUPPORTS

This bill phases in ESAs for every student by the year 2020, expanding school choice to all parents and students in the state.

HB 2495/1152 (consolidated election dates; tax authorization)--AZFEC SUPPORTS

This bill would require questions of local tax increases be put to voters at a general election. This bill stops cities from pursuing tax hikes in low turnout months that increases their likelihood of passage.

HB 2492 (jobs; incentives; credits; grants)--AZFEC OPPOSES

Would make the current carry forward R&D tax credits, available to a few large manufacturers in the state, refundable and able to be applied to TPT liabilities.

HB 2191/SB1212 (angel investor; tax credit cap)--AZFEC OPPOSES

This bill the Club dubbed "the Shark Tank Bill" wealthy venture capitalists to receive tax credits for investing in risky new business start-ups.

HB 2530/SB 1212 (Rural Development; tax credit)— AZFEC OPPOSES

This bill allows qualifying Rural Investment Firms to raise investment capital in order to capture and sell 60 percent corporate income tax, individual income tax, or premium insurance tax credits. Program allocates \$30 million in tax credits.

HB 2404 (initiatives; circulators; signature collection; contests)--AZFEC SUPPORTS

Prohibits campaigns from paying petition gatherers from paying per signature

SB 1147 (county election; motor fuel taxes)

Allows counties to levy a 10 cent motor fuel tax upon approval of voters.

SB 1270 (reauthorization; county transportation excise tax)

Allows counties to send their transportation excise tax to voters early. Locked in funding percentages for light rail

SB 1437 (Right to Earn a Living)--AZFEC SUPPORTS

Goldwater bill requires an agency to limit occupational regulations to that which are necessary to fulfill a specific public health, safety or welfare concern.

HB 2244 (initiatives; standard of review; handbook)--AZFEC SUPPORTS

Creates a higher standard of judicial review for proposed initiatives

HB 2369 (Repeal State Board/Contract Lobbyist Prohibition for universities)--AZFEC SUPPORTS

Included an amendment that prohibits public universities from hiring contract lobbyists

HB 2422 (annual report; corporate tax credits)--AZFEC SUPPORTS

This bill requires the Department of Revenue to report annually tax credits and carry forwards in excess of \$5,000 claimed by corporations

2018 Budget

Included \$7 million appropriation to Freedom Centers at the Universities
